

San Antonio Automated Waste Collection System Oakmont Downs

Containers will be delivered to the area on the following schedule:

June 8: 7 gal blue container for indoor use

June 15: 96 gal blue & brown containers (1 each)

Call 311 if you have not received your containers on these dates.

Pickup dates will be Tuesday (recyclables) & Friday (trash).

First pickup dates: June 23 (Tuesday) and June 26 (Friday)

The blue can is for recyclables; the brown can is for Household Non-Hazardous Waste (no paints, oils, chemicals, etc)



Cans are to be placed in the street on the day of pickup with at least five feet of clearance from vehicles, trees, etc.

If the pickup date is a major holiday, notice will be given for the appropriate pickup date

Waste containers have serial numbers that will be matched to your property. In the event of damage or theft, you may request a replacement at no additional charge. These containers remain the property of the City of San Antonio and may not be defaced, etc.

Smaller cans (48 gal) are available on request for seniors or those with disabilities

A disabled form for those unable to move their cans to the street is available on request that permits pickup drivers to enter your property to retrieve the cans. These forms must be signed by a physician.

All trash placed in the brown container is to be bagged. Bagged yard waste is permitted.

No plastic bags or hazardous materials are to be placed in the blue containers.
Glass and junk mail are recyclables and may be placed in the blue container.
Shredded paper should be placed in paper bags and not left loose.

Additional recycling containers are available on request at no charge. There will be an additional service fee if additional trash containers are used.
